



MOLDS - QTY 17

The molds are part of a set that make Polypro plastic entryway door and window frames. The following size frames are as follows:

22" x 36" 1 lite, 9 lite, round top 1 lite, round top 12 lite

22" x 64" 1 lite, 15 lite, round top 1 lite, round top

22" x 10" 1 lite, 5 lite

7" x 64" 1 lite, 5 lite

8" x 36" 1 lite

6" x 64" 1 lite

20" x 64" 1 lite, 15 lite

22" x 6" 1 lite

20" x 36" 1 lite, 9 lite, 12 lite diamond

14" x 37" Oval 1 lite

7" x 18" 1 lite

8" x 6" 1 lite

There are two molds that make duplicate parts because they are high volume molds. The 22 x 36 and the 22 x 64 molds have duplicate molds. There is one jam mold that is 8 x 64. There are also two plug molds that make plugs that fill the hole side of each frame set. One mold makes smaller plugs for the 22 x 10 parts and the 14 x 37 ovals and the other plug mold, makes plugs for the rest of the molds.

Attached are a few samples of the frames these molds make. Their application is that they are used to seal and hold in glass into an entryway door or window. These are standard sizes that are used through out the industry by all major door and window manufacturers (Peachtree, Anderson, Pella, Marvin, Jeldwen, Larson, Midwest Manufacturing, TermaTru, etc.). Some of these door and window manufacturers have their own molds, but often use these commodity frames as back up when theirs are broken or backlogged.
